H. Nadia Moore, Ph.D., is a board certified toxicologist at Veritox® whose background includes toxicology, regulatory compliance, molecular biology, and chemistry. She has led research and testing efforts in characterization of the toxicological and carcinogenic potential of chemicals, mixtures, and agents. Dr. Moore has experience in preparation of risk-based toxicology assessments for potential contaminants in consumer products and workplace exposures; preparation of toxicology assessments for regulatory agencies using laboratory- and literature-based techniques; and toxicology literature database design and population. Her experience includes a practicing-scientist membership in an Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC); oversight of scientific, technical, and procedural conduct for GLP-compliant subchronic and chronic studies; and overall conduct, interpretation, and reporting of studies.
